Adams/Cheshire/Lanesborough

Ashuwillticook Rail Trail – Paved biking/walking path from Hoosic St Adams to Route 8

Lanesborough, along Cheshire Reservoir and Berkshire Pond

Cheshire Reservoir – Cheshire, north end-view from boat launch

Cheshire Reservoir – central area-view from Farnum’s Crossing Road (“the causeway”) across from Whitney’s Farm stand

Cheshire Reservoir– south end – view from Nobody’s Road

Cheshire-Stafford Hill Wildlife Management Area, Jenks Road, trails thru meadows and varied habitat

Clarksburg

Clarksburg State Park-1199 Middle Road-woodland trails and Mausert’s Pond

Florida

Monroe State Forest-Tilda Hill Road, Florida-Dunbar Loop Trail - woodlands

Mt. Greylock

Visitor’s Center- Rockwell Road, Lanesborough- trail access thru parking lot Notch Road, North Adams
Jones’ Nose , Rockwell Rd

Upper intersection of Rockwell Rd and Notch Road– walk down trail a short distance to small pond

Summit – take several trails around summit

Greylock Glen-West Mountain Road, Adams, highland meadows and forest trails

Greylock Glen –Gould/Thiel Roads, Adams-mixed forest, fields and small wetlands

North Adams

Bellows Pipe Trail – corner of Notch and Reservoir Road

Bradley Farm Trail-Notch Road, starts at the Greylock Gate

Mount Williams Reservoir – Pattison Road via Notch Road from North Adams or Luce Road from Wmst

Natural Bridge State Park – McAuley Road, abandoned marble quarry, gorge, trails

Southview Cemetery – Church Street-hedgerow along railroad tracks good place to look, borders Hoosic River

Tourists’ Hotel Trail – 915 State Road, footbridge across Hoosic River and trail

Windsor Lake – top of Cliff Street and Kemp Avenue in North Adams, trails, swimming, campground

Savoy

Savoy Mountain State Forest-260 Central Shaft Road, Florida-Spruce Hill hawkwatching and Tannery Falls, woodland trails

Williamstown

Bridges Pond – Trail access from Route 7 near Moody Bridge (near 635 Simons Road)
Clark Art Museum/ Stone Hill – 225 South Street, Trails from upper parking lot
Eph Pond- Stetson Road-Near Williams College campus, pond and trails along the Hoosic River
Field Farm – Trustees Property – 554 Sloan Road – trails in woodlands, meadows and ponds
Hopkins Memorial Forest of Williams College – 271 Northwest Hill Road – woodland trails
Hopper Road, base of Mount Greylock – Green River Road, Route 43
Linear Park – Entrance Across from Maple Terrace Motel on Route 2, 555 Main St, trails in woodlands along river
Mountain Meadow Preserve – West entrance/car lot top of Mason St. across from Chef's Hat Route 7
East entrance for trail access also from White Oaks Road to Benedict Road
Moore's Pond – 671 Simonds Road (Route 7) (dump road!)
Northwest Hill Road –walking along road in various sections of birdy woodlands
Sheep Hill – Williamstown Rural Lands Foundation – 671 Cold Spring Road (Route 7)-trails
Taconic Trail State Park– Route 2 heading west to New York, parking lot top of ridge, woodland trails

Windsor

Notchview Reservation, Trustees property, Route 9, Nordic skiing in winter, woodland trails
Moran Wildlife Management Area-Route 8A-woodland trails, marshes
Windsor State Forest-River Road -Windsor Jams Waterfall-trails
